## **ECHO**))) **THE GOSPEL TO THE ENDS OF THE EARTH**

Until recently I had never given much thought to the word *echo*. I knew what it meant—basically an echo is a sound heard again (a repetition) of an original sound. However, a key word in its definition has grabbed my attention. **An echo is a reflection/repetition (of sound).** We are going to focus on some of the God's character which echoes God's thought.

Exodus 34:6 – “And he passed in front of Moses, proclaiming, “The LORD, the LORD, the compassionate and gracious God, slow to anger, abounding in love and faithfulness...”

Let's dive into the book of Jonah and see how God portrays every aspect of His character that we've just read in Exodus 34.

### **1. God is compassionate**

God's compassion means that He doesn't just see our trouble, but He also seeks to put things right. We see this reality most clearly through Jesus, whose life mission was to restore everything that had gone wrong and caused us pain. In Jonah 1:2 "Go to the great city of Nineveh and preach against it, because its wickedness has come up before me." He is so compassionate that He will not wait for us but is willing to make the first move to help us find Him.

### **2. God is gracious**

People of Nineveh acted wickedly but God still chose to give them a chance. Many times though we forgive people, it's hard for us to entrust them with the same mission again. God was gracious enough to trust Jonah with His mission in spite of Jonah's disobedience.

### **3. God is abounding in love**

God's love is for everyone. It is interesting to note that He keeps a record of the number of people in the city (Jonah 4:11). God has a loving heart for everyone to even leave the ninety nine and go behind the one that's lost, like we learn from one of the parables. God's love is the same for everyone who seeks Him. All He wants is to see every one saved. The purpose of His judgement was to correct and not to punish.

### **4. God is slow to anger and He is faithful**

As in Jonah 1:10, God speaks to us in various ways to correct us. In this case, God used the sailors to ask Jonah questions that would get him to realize his mistake. We sometimes may ignore the warnings that God gives us through others around us. Though Jonah was happy that he was given grace for his mistake, he was not happy about the grace that the Ninevites received. However, God because of His faithfulness, tenderly ministers to him through an object lesson and gets him to understand what He feels like.

### **5. God relents from sending calamity**

God forgives Jonah for a reason. He expects Jonah to complete the mission that He had originally called him for. Ask yourself what you could do in return for His forgiveness. God LOVES to forgive people because He alone knows the price He had to pay. It is His nature to forgive! Jonah forgot the original purpose of the Jews being a blessing to the rest of the world and did not want a pagan nation to be saved. But we see that God never forgets what He promises and was more concerned than Jonah was about the people of Nineveh.

**How can you echo the Gospel to the ends of the earth  
if you are not willing to echo God's character!**

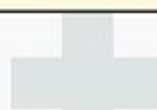
