THE *IMPORTANCE* *OF* DEATH

Today marks the beginning of the celebration of the most momentous week in history, certainly the most important week in the life of every believer. We call it "Holy Week"—a sacred time when we remember the final events in the life of Jesus leading up to His death on the cross of Calvary. It was a week of extremes—from the great exultation of Palm Sunday to the great grief and anguish of Good Friday.

What was the most important event of this momentous week? Was it Christ's Triumphant entry into Jerusalem when the crowds hailed Him as King with shouts of "Hosanna?" Was it the commemoration of the Passover, the Last Supper, when Jesus modeled the importance of servanthood by donning a towel and washing the feet of His disciples? Was it Jesus' powerful teaching on love, the greatest commandment? Or His promise of the coming of the Holy Spirit? As significant as all of these things are, the most important theme of this week was DEATH.

Death is a subject we all shrink from; we do not like to discuss it or even think about it. The Apostle Paul, however, tells us that the death of Christ is of *first importance* for the believer. *"For what I received I passed on to you of first importance: that Christ died for our sins..."* 1 Corinthians 15:3.

Let us consider two things about death.

First, we are all condemned to die. The sentence of death fell on the human race in the Garden of Eden. Paul states it clearly, *"in Adam all die"* - 1 Corinthians 15:22. Adam's disobedience planted the seed of sin to which we all fall victim. God's word is also clear on the subject of the necessity of punishment for sin. *"The soul who sins, shall die"* Ezekiel 18:4. *"The wages of sin is death"* Romans 6:23.

Secondly, Christ's death was substitutionary. The marvel of Christ's death is that it was "for our sins." We sing the beautiful chorus: "I owed a debt I could not pay; He paid a debt He did not owe." Wonder of wonders: He died in my place! *"He Himself bore our sins in His body on the tree, so that we might die to sin and live for righteousness"* 1 Peter 2:24.
