Celebrating — OUR — "CALEBS" STILL BEARING FRUIT



Calebs Sunday is a special occasion when we celebrate the treasured saints among us - the "Calebs" of our congregation. Their lives remind us that faithfulness is not measured by age but by devotion to God. As we honour our seniors, we also learn valuable lessons about perseverance, purpose, and respect from the Bible.

I. The Significance of Calebs in the Church

The senior members of the church are not merely witnesses to the past; they are pillars of wisdom, faith, and spiritual stability. Throughout Scripture, God used older men and women to guide His people. The Psalmist declares, "*They will still bear fruit in old age, they will stay fresh and green*" (Psalm 92:14). Their prayers, testimonies, and godly counsel strengthen the church and provide direction to younger generations.

Just as elders sat at the gates of ancient Israel to offer wisdom and judgment, the seniors in our church today serve as living testimonies of God's faithfulness. Their experiences help younger believers navigate life's challenges with greater wisdom and discernment.

2. Honouring the Calebs Among Us

Scripture repeatedly commands us to honour those who are older. *"Stand up in the presence of the aged, show respect for the elderly and revere your God"* (Leviticus 19:32). The Apostle Paul instructed Timothy to *treat older men as fathers and older women as mothers* (1 Timothy 5:1-2).

The younger generation has much to gain by listening to and learning from their elders. In our homes, children and grandchildren should value the wisdom and sacrifices of their parents and grandparents. In the church, younger believers should seek opportunities to serve, encourage, and learn from senior members. Honouring our elders is more than a cultural courtesy; it is a biblical responsibility that reflects our gratitude to God for the lives He has used to shape us.

3. Calebs Never Retire from God's Calling

The Bible presents remarkable examples of men and women who continued serving God with passion even in their later years. Caleb himself stands as the greatest example. At eighty-five years of age, he boldly declared, *"I am still as strong today as the day Moses sent me out"* (Joshua 14:11). Instead of seeking comfort, he asked for the hill country and continued pursuing God's promises.

Moses was eighty when God called him to lead Israel out of Egypt. Anna the prophetess served faithfully in the temple and recognised the Messiah in her old age (Luke 2:36 - 38). Simeon, guided by the Holy Spirit, rejoiced upon seeing the infant Jesus. These examples remind us that God's purposes do not have an expiry date. While careers may end, and earthly responsibilities may change, the call to pray, mentor, encourage, and serve remains. In God's kingdom, there is no retirement from faithful discipleship.

As we celebrate Calebs Sunday, we thank God for the faithful men and women who have walked with Him through the seasons of life and continue to shine as examples of steadfast faith. Their lives testify that God's grace sustains, His promises endure, and His calling remains active until life's final breath. May we cherish their wisdom, honour their legacy, and learn from their example. May every generation in our church walk closely with the Lord and flourish in God's blessings.


