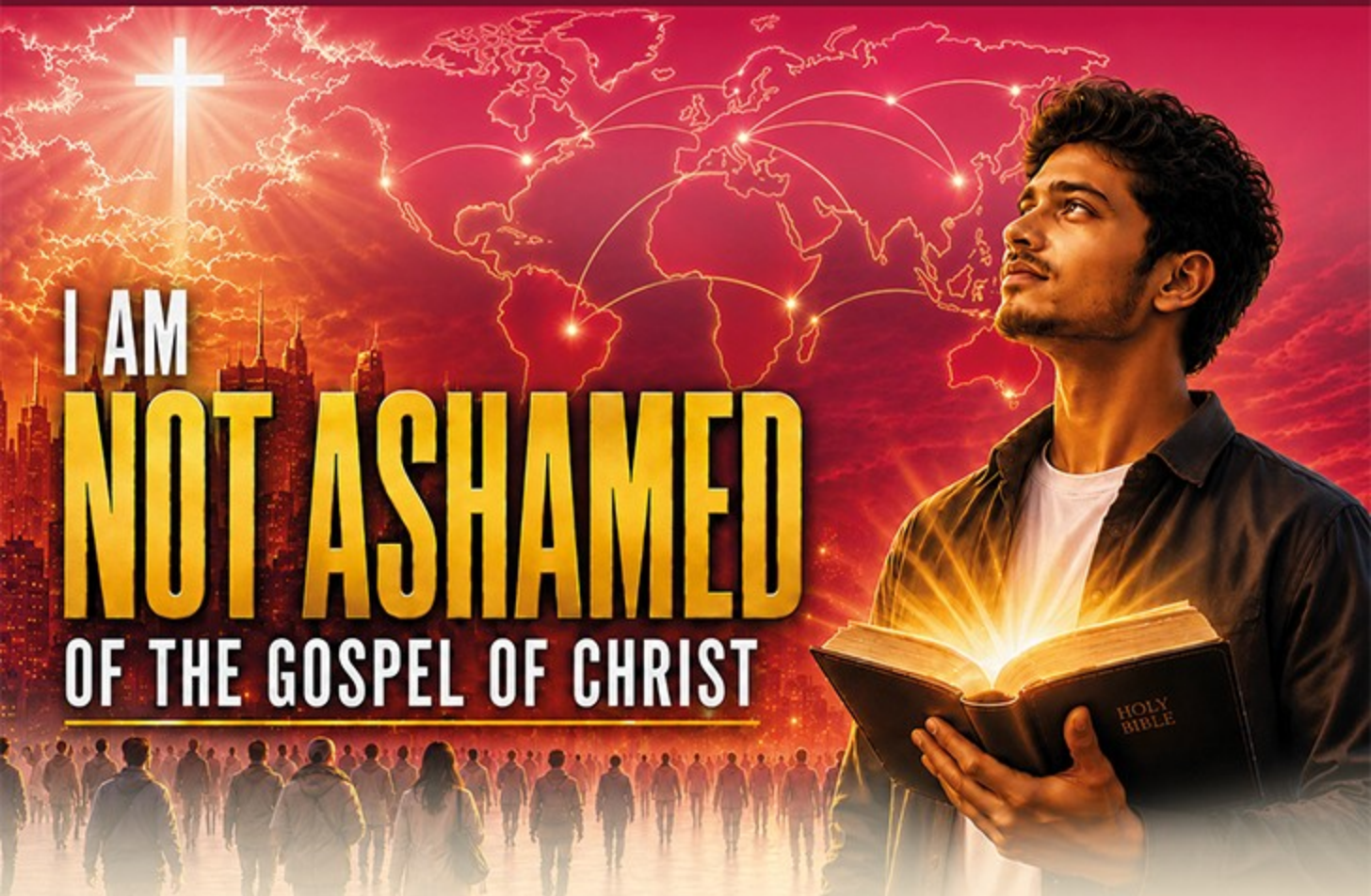

Being Not Ashamed of the Truth

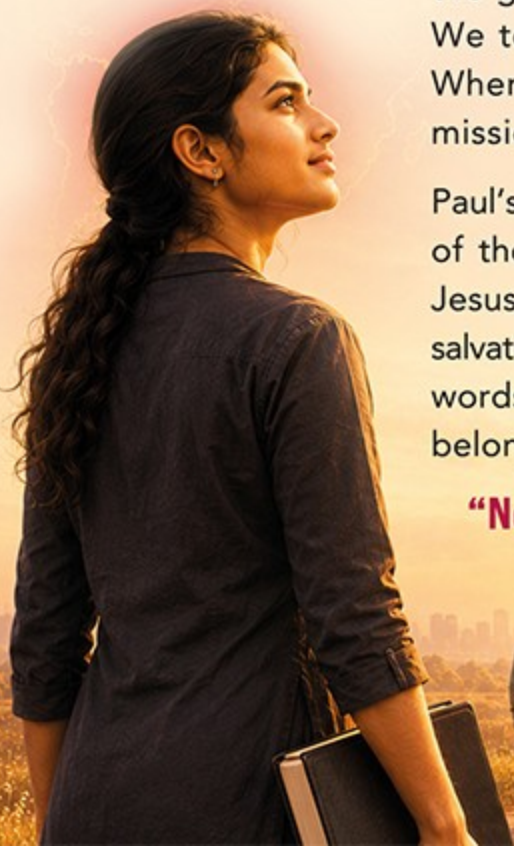
