## COMPELLED BY *Love*

**"For the love of Christ compels us..."**

2 CORINTHIANS 5:14

As we prepare for our Missions Convention next week, it is worth looking at the life of one of the greatest missionaries in Scripture - the Apostle Paul.

Paul's missionary journeys covered an extraordinary distance. Estimates vary depending on how the routes are calculated, but his three major missionary journeys together covered approximately 12,000 – 13,000 kms. Including his journey to Rome, the total may have exceeded 16,000 kms. And remember how he traveled: there were no airplanes, cars, trains, or comfortable highways. Large portions of his journeys were made on foot, over rough terrain and ancient roads, while other portions were by ship. That is an incredible amount of travel - but what is even more remarkable is why he kept going. Paul did not simply believe in missions; he was **compelled by the love of Christ** to make Christ known.



## **1. LOVE SENDS US BEYOND OUR COMFORT**

Paul continually moved beyond what was familiar. He crossed cultural, geographical, and religious boundaries to take the gospel to people who had never heard it. We see an example of this in Acts 16 where God redirected him toward Macedonia, opening the door for the gospel to enter Europe. Paul understood that the gospel was too important to remain within the boundaries of his own comfort. Missions begins when love becomes greater than comfort. We may not all be called to travel thousands of miles, but all of us are called to reach beyond ourselves.

## **2. LOVE MAKES US PERSEVERE THROUGH DIFFICULTY**

Paul's journeys were not comfortable missionary tours. He experienced opposition, rejection, beatings, imprisonment, danger, and shipwrecks. He describes some of his experiences in 2 Corinthians 11:24-27. Yet he kept going. Paul's ministry was not driven by convenience. It was driven by conviction, and ultimately by the love of Christ. There will always be reasons why we cannot go, but love compels us to ask, "Who will reach them if we don't?"

## **3. LOVE SEES PEOPLE, NOT JUST PLACES**

Paul traveled through dozens of cities, but his mission was never really about cities. It was about people. In Philippi, he met Lydia. In Athens, he spoke to philosophers. In Corinth, he ministered to a diverse population. In Ephesus, he spent years teaching and discipling believers. Every city represented people who needed Jesus. We can talk about nations, statistics, missionaries, and projects, but behind every statistic is a person created in the image of God. Missions is not primarily about reaching places. It is about reaching people.

## **4. LOVE MAKES EVERY BELIEVER A PARTICIPANT**

Paul went, but he did not go alone. Churches prayed, believers supported him, people opened their homes, and others traveled with him. The mission belonged to the whole church. The same is true today. Some are called to go. Some are called to send. Some are called to give. Some are called to pray. But all of us are called to participate.

Paul traveled thousands of miles because he was compelled by love. He crossed seas, walked dangerous roads, entered hostile cities, endured persecution, and continued preaching Christ because the love of Christ would not allow him to remain silent. May this Missions Convention awaken in us the same passion that drove Paul - to pray, to give, to go, and to make Christ known wherever God sends us.
